

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
March 8, 2018**

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Grosse Tete held their regular meeting at the Town Hall in Grosse Tete March 8, 2018 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Alderman Marcus Hill led the Prayer. Deisha Chaney, a citizen of the community led the Pledge and the Meeting began.

Demink Hill – Addressed the Mayor and Board of Alderman about having an Easter Parade. She will bring details back to the Town Hall.

Variance - Alderman Clint Seneca made a motion to grant a variance to Charles Washington allowing him to move an existing mobile home within the Village of Grosse Tete to another parcel of property within the Village of Grosse Tete because the owner of the property is in the process of selling the property where the mobile home is parked and it has to be moved. This motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David and passed 3 – 0.

Minutes: Alderman Marcus Hill made a motion to dispense with the reading and approve the minutes from the February 8, 2018 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Clint Seneca and passed 3 - 0.

Sidewalk Project – Contracts have been awarded and signed. A pre-construction meeting will be schedule this month to set a start date for the project.

Police Department – Chief Dardenne stated that he was working towards getting set up for electronic tickets.

Fire Department – Chief Hughes he would like to have a Resolution passed to impose a \$2.00 per bed tax for any hotels build within the Village of Grosse Tete. Attorney Larry Bossier will research this item and bring information back to the Board.
