

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES  
REGULAR MEETING  
April 14, 2016**

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Grosse Tete held their regular meeting at the Town Hall in Grosse Tete April 14, 2016 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Alderman Marcus Hill led the Prayer followed by the pledge led by Alderwoman Kyle Booksh. Mayor Chauffe called roll and the meeting began.
