

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
April 13, 2017**

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Grosse Tete held their regular meeting at the Town Hall in Grosse Tete April 13, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Attorney Larry Bossier led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Alderman Clint Seneca and the Meeting began.
