

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES  
REGULAR MEETING  
December 14, 2017**

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Grosse Tete held their regular meeting at the Town Hall in Grosse Tete December 14, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Attorney Larry Bossier led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Alderman Marcus Hill and the Meeting began.

**Minutes:** Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to dispense with the reading and approve the minutes with a change of the first line of the Mayor's Report being stated as the Sidewalk Project and not the Walking Trail from the November 9, 2017 regular meeting. **Ordinance number 2 of 2017 for the adoption of the 2018 Budget** – Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to adopt Ordinance Number 2 of 2017 to adopt the 2018 Budget. This motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 2 – 0.

**Ordinance number 3 of 2017 to change the Position of Chief of Police from Part Time to Full Time** – Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to adopt Ordinance Number 2 of 2017 to change the position of Chief of Police from Part Time to Full Time effective January 1, 2018. This motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 2 – 0.

**Ordinance number 4 of 2017 to increase the Salary of the Chief of Police** – Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to adopt Ordinance number 4 of 2017 to set the salary for the Chief of Police at Forty Two Thousand and no/100 dollars (\$42,000.00) per year. This motion was seconded Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 2 – 0.

- The latest information we have received on the Sidewalk Project is that it will be let for bid in January 2018.
- Bids for The Walking Trail will be opened on December 20, 2017 @ 3:00 p.m.
