

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
January 13, 2022**

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the January 13, 2022 meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Fire Chief Michael Hughes led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Kyle Booksh and the Meeting began.

Julie Wessinger: Ms. Wessinger addressed the Board of Alderman and the Mayor in regards to concerns about the construction of Tiger Truck Stop. She stated that the residents of Garner Lane were having issues with dust, traffic, and the uncovered gravel pile on the truck stop property. Another citizen discussed traffic overflow in the Truck Stop parking lot causing vehicles to have to back up and often time has reverse alerts that causes noise complaint issues. The Grosse Tete Town Attorney stated that the Village of Grosse Tete has no specific jurisdiction over the construction and suggested that citizens contact Tiger Truck Stop Owners in a civil fashion.
