

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
June 9, 2016**

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Grosse Tete held their regular meeting at the Town Hall in Grosse Tete June 9, 2016 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Alderman Kyle Booksh led the Prayer which was followed by the pledge led by Mayor Michael Chauffe.

Present: Mayor Michael Chauffe, Alderman Kyle Booksh, Alderman Marcus Hill, Alderwoman Jeanie David, Maintenance Supervisor Phillip Faveroth, Clerk Pam George, and Chief of Police Tommy Dardenne

Absent: Fire Chief Michael Hughes

Discuss and approve permits – There was one permit submitted for approval. After much discussion, Alderwoman Jeanie David moved to issue a variance to allow a mobile home that is older than that allowed in Ordinance 2 of 2013 (Section 26-54) to be moved into the Village of Grosse Tete. Alderwoman David explained her reasoning for the motion was because the Mobile Home being discussed was a newer model and in better condition than the mobile home currently at the location. The motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill. Alderman Kyle Booksh abstained from voting. The motion passed 2 yeas, 0 nays, and 1 abstention.

Minutes: Alderman Kyle Booksh made a motion to dispense with the reading and approve the minutes from the May 12, 2016 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 2 - 0.

Finances: Alderman Kyle Booksh made a motion to approve the financial statements of May 31, 2016 as presented. This motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David and passed 3 - 0.

Mayor's Report:

Selection of Official Journal – A motion was made by Alderman Marcus Hill to select The Plaquemine Post South as the Official Journal for the Village of Grosse Tete. This motion was seconded by Alderman Kyle Booksh and passed 3 – 0.

Resolution – A Resolution allowing Mayor Chauffe to Apply for a grant through Community Water Enrichment Fund – The vote for the above titled resolution was

cast as follows: YEAS: Alderman Kyle Booksh, Alderwoman Jeanie David and Alderman Marcus Hill NAYS: None ABSTENTIONS: None

Mayor Chauffe gave updates on the following projects:

- * The new playground equipment for the smaller children (ages 2 – 5) has been installed.
- * The State has sent drawings back to Forte & Tablada for the sidewalk project and is due back to DOTD by July 1, 2016.
- * The sewer extension on Big Dee Drive is in the final planning stages and construction should start soon.

He also reminded the Board of Alderman of the LMA District H meeting in Baker on July 16, 2016, of which he and the Board of Alderman plan to attend.
