

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
March 16, 2022**

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the March 16, 2022 meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Phillip Faveroth led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Fire Chief Danny Gantt and the Meeting began.
