

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES  
REGULAR MEETING  
November 10, 2016**

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Grosse Tete held their regular meeting at the Town Hall in Grosse Tete November 10, 2016 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Fire Chief Mike Hughes led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Police Chief Tommy Dardenne and the Meeting began.

**Minutes:** Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to dispense with the reading and approve the minutes from the October 31, 2016 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Kyle Booksh and passed 2 - 0.

**Finances:** Alderman Kyle Booksh made a motion to approve the financial statements of September 30, 2016 as presented. This motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David and passed 2 - 0.

**Introduction of 2016 Budget Amendments and Proposed 2017 Budget** – A motion was made by Alderwoman Jeanie David and seconded by Alderman Kyle Booksh to set a public hearing for the Amended Budget and the Proposed Budget to be held on December 8, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. This motion passed 2 – 0.

**Grosse Tete Post Office** – No Representative from the Postal Service was present. There were citizens from the community who voiced their issues with the Mayor and Board of Alderman.

**Ordinance Number 3 of 2016** – A motion was made by Alderman Kyle Booksh and seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David to adopt Ordinance Number 3 of 2016. This motion passed 2 – 0.

**Pay Raises** – Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to amend the agenda to introduce Ordinance Number 5 of 2016 - Pay Raises for elected and appointed officials. This motion was seconded by Alderman Kyle Booksh and passed 3 – 0.

Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to set a public hearing for Ordinance Number 5 of 2016 to be held on December 8, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. This motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 3 – 0.

**Christmas on the Bayou** – Alderwoman Jeanie David stated that Christmas on the Bayou would be held on December 4, 2016. The parade will begin at 1:00 p.m. south of the railroad track and proceed north on highway 77 to the Welcome Center where the festival will be held.

**Mayors Report:**

Sidewalk Project – The project seems to be moving again. Documents have been signed to proceed and the Engineer feels certain the project will be let for bids in the spring.

Jessie Thompson from Hess Engineers stated that bid opening for the Sewer Baffles would be November 17, 2016.
