

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
October 12, 2017**

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Grosse Tete held their regular meeting at the Town Hall in Grosse Tete October 12, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Alderman Marcus Hill and the Meeting began.

Minutes: Alderman Marcus Hill made a motion to dispense with the reading and approve the minutes from the September 14, 2017 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Clint Seneca and passed 3 - 0.

Mayor's Report:

- Sidewalk project will not be let for bid in September. The latest information we have received is that it will be let for bid in January 2018.
- The Village of Grosse Tete was awarded DRA money for sewer pumps in the amount of \$30,000.00
- Janet Marionneaux, Grant writer gave an update stated that the Village of Grosse Tete was granted notice to proceed on the Walking Trail Grants.

Amend the Agenda: A motion was made by Alderwoman Jeanie David and seconded by Alderman Clint Seneca to amend the Agenda to add: Request for permission to advertise for the bids for the walking trail. This motion passed 3 – 0.

Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to grant permission to advertise for bids for the walking trail. This motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 3 - 0

Police Department – Chief Dardenne stated that the Marionneaux property has been cleared and cleaned up. He provided pictures to the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the cleared property. Chief Dardenne announced that he will be retiring from the Iberville Parish Sheriff's

Office as of December 31, 2017. He also stated that he is interested in creating a full-time police department for the Village of Grosse Tete.

Fire Department – Chief Hughes stated that 2018 would be the rating year for the Village of Grosse Tete.
