

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
September 14, 2017**

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Grosse Tete held their regular meeting at the Town Hall in Grosse Tete September 14, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Attorney Larry Bossier led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Alderman Clint Seneca and the Meeting began.

Present: Mayor Michael Chauffe, Alderman Kyle Booksh, Alderman Marcus Hill, Maintenance Supervisor Phillip Faveroth, Clerk Pam George, and Chief of Police Tommy Dardenne

Absent: Fire Chief Michael Hughes and Alderwoman Jeanie David

Senator Rick Ward – Senator Ward’s secretary called and stated that he was unable to attend the meeting and would call back to schedule later date.

Minutes: Alderman Marcus Hill made a motion to dispense with the reading and approve the minutes from the August 10, 2017 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Clint Seneca and passed 2 - 0.

Finances: Alderman Clint Seneca made a motion to approve the financial statements of August 31, 2017 as presented. This motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 2 - 0.

New Comprehensive Animal Control Ordinance – After a public hearing had been held, A motion was made by Alderman Clint Seneca and seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill to adopt the New Comprehensive Animal Control Ordinance. This motion passed 2 – 0.

Mayor’s Report:

- Sidewalk project will not be let for bid in September. DOTD said they will notify us when it is ready to be let for bids.
- Mayor Chauffe stated appreciation for the Village of Rosedale for allowing us to get water from them to keep our water system from going down.
- Mayor Chauffe stated that Village of Grosse Tete is interested in purchasing chrome books for the board to be used for monthly meetings. These laptops will be kept at the Town Hall and ready for use at each meeting.
- A great deal of the junk at the Marionneaux Property has been cleaned up. An employee was in attendance and stated that the remaining items will be addressed in the next couple days.

A motion was made by Alderman Marcus Hill to NOT allow any more extension for the Clean-up of the Marionneaux property and to grant Mayor Chauffe authority to hire a licensed and insured person or business to remove the junk from the Marionneaux property that is still on the property located in Grosse Tete. This motion was seconded by Alderman Clint Seneca

- Janet Marionneaux, Grant writer gave an update on the Walking Trail Grants.
