

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES  
REGULAR MEETING  
September 15, 2021**

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the September 15, 2021 meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Fire Chief Mike Hughes led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Attorney Robert Marionneaux and the Meeting began.

**Present:** Mayor Michael Chauffe, Alderwoman Jeanie David, Alderman Marcus Hill, Maintenance Supervisor Phillip Faveroth, Chief of Police Tommy Dardenne, Clerk Pam George, Attorney Robert Marionneaux, Alderman Clint Seneca and Fire Chief Mike Hughes.

**Absent:** None

**Minutes:** Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of August 12, 2021. The motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 3 – 0.

**Finances:** Alderman Clint Seneca made a motion to approve the financial statements of August 31, 2021. This motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David and passed 3 – 0.

Jeanie David – Grass, Town Hall and Traffic: Ms. David stated that she was concerned about the grass in the ditches not being maintained along Highway 77 south of the Town Hall. Maintenance Supervisor stated he would check on the area discussed. She also stated that the Town Hall needed a face lift and that she wanted Mayor Chauffe to look into possible renovations. She addressed the Chief of Police about people speeding on Highway 77.

**Mayor's Report:**

- LaMats Purchasing Agreement – A Resolution was presented to the Board of Alderman to grant permission to Mayor Chauffe to enter into a Purchasing Agreement. The Resolution was voted on as follows: YEAS: Jeanie David, Marcus Hill and Clint Seneca. NAYS: None
- After discussion, it has been decided that Boo on the Bayou, The Veteran's Program and Christmas on the Bayou will be cancelled again this year due to Covid.
- A Resolution to authorize Mayor Chauffe to enter into a cooperative endeavor agreement and sign and execute any and all related contracts and forms for capital outlay project Number 50-MB6-21-01 was voted on as follows: YEAS: Jeanie David, Marcus Hill and Clint Seneca NAYS: None

**Police Department** – Chief Dardenne stated that the Iberville Parish Sheriff offered to donate another vehicle to the Grosse Tete Police Department. Alderman Clint Seneca made a motion to grant permission to Chief Dardenne to sign any and all documents necessary to accept the donation and have the vehicle title changed to the ownership of the Village of Grosse Tete. This motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 3 – 0.

Chief Dardenne introduced Ordinance Number 4 of 2021 to govern carless operation of a motor vehicle within the corporate limits of the Village of Grosse Tete. A motion was made by Alderman Clint Seneca and seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill to set a public hearing to be held on October 14, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. The motion passed 3 – 0.

**Fire Department - No Report**

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:46p.m.
